Preparing for the Comprehensive Examination

Taking the Comprehensive Examination

The comprehensive examination committee will determine the dates of the exam and the timeframe for the students to return their responses. Both the exam and response return dates will be provided to the student well in advance of taking the exam to minimize inygthgtgpeg qh gzvgtpcn gpvkvkgu (k.g., lqdu, hc okn{ kuuwgu, gve í).
